

REACHING ANCONA: A TRANSPORTATION GUIDE

Primary Air Travel: [Ancona Falconara Airport](#) is the most convenient arrival point for those attending the conference. Upon exiting the terminal, travelers may access taxi services and shuttle transport located immediately outside the airport entrance.

[The Raffaello Aerobus](#) provides a dedicated shuttle service connecting the airport with key locations in Ancona, specifically Piazza Cavour, the central railway station, and Torrette. It also services the Falconara Marittima railway station.

- Operating Hours: the service is available daily from 07:00 to 22:30.
- Ticketing: passengers may purchase tickets directly on board the bus. The fare is 3.30 Euro for destinations in Falconara and 5.50 Euro for Ancona.
- Further Information: comprehensive schedules and route details are available on the official service webpage.

As alternatives, visitors may utilize [Bologna Airport](#) or [Pescara Airport](#). From these locations, the most efficient method to reach Ancona is by rail.

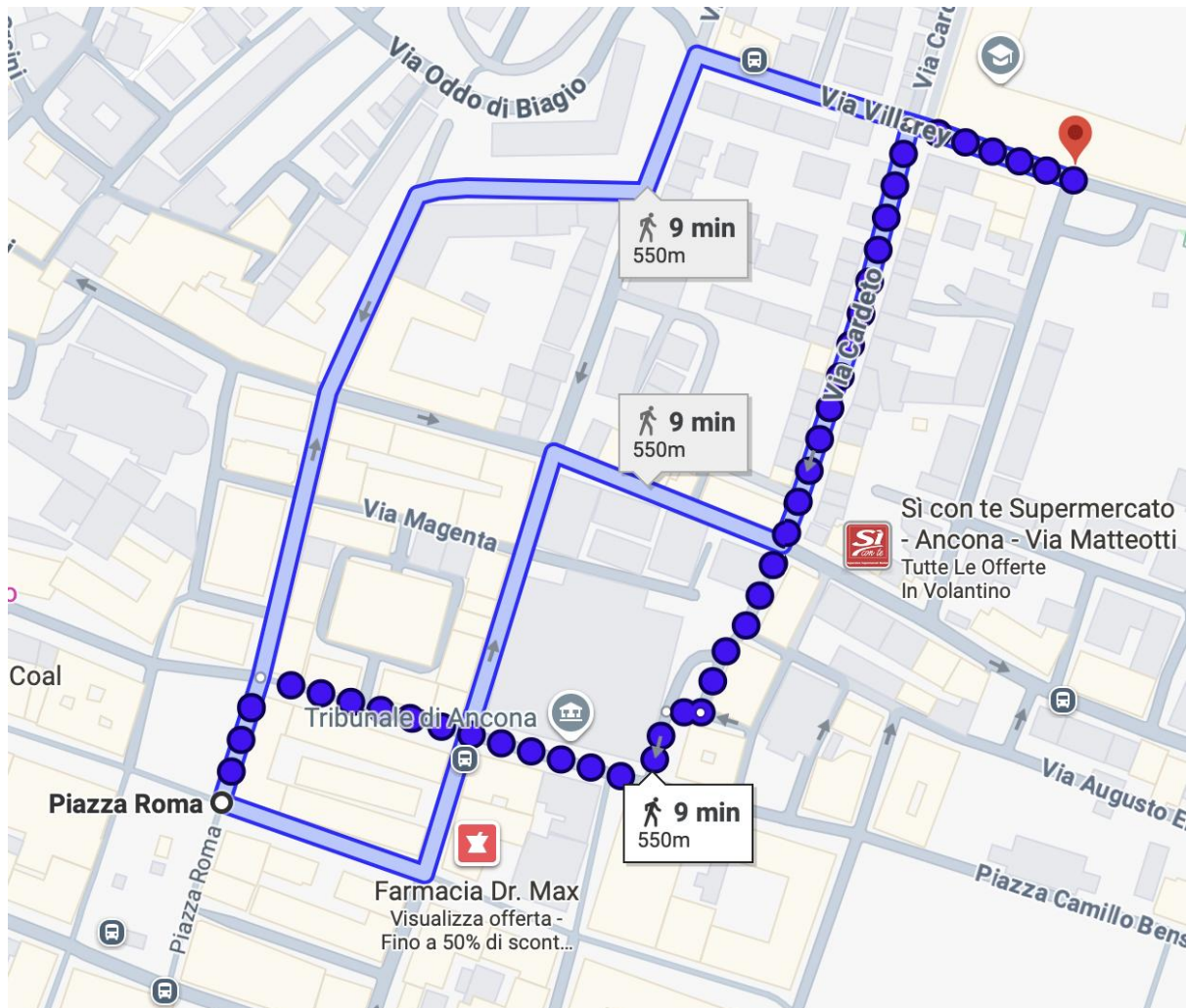
- Departure Stations: it is recommended that travelers depart from Bologna Centrale or Pescara Centrale.
- Rail Schedules: detailed information regarding train times and ticket reservations can be found on the Trenitalia website at <http://www.trenitalia.com/>.

Upon arrival at the Ancona railway station, the city center is most effectively accessed through the municipal bus system (or taxi services in front of the station). The **1/4 bus line**, which operates with regular frequency in the direction of **Piazza IV Novembre**, provides direct transit to the central urban areas. Passengers should ensure that tickets are acquired in advance from authorized distributors situated within the station complex or at nearby kiosks. Single trip ticket sums up 1.25 Euro. This route offers a convenient and rapid transition from the transport hub to the city center.

UNIVERSITY ACCESS FOR OUTLYING ACCOMMODATIONS

For participants whose accommodations are not situated within the immediate city center, the university campus may be reached by disembarking at either Piazza Roma or Piazza Cavour. These locations function as equivalent transit points for accessing the university facilities and represent the most direct route for those traveling from other sectors of the city (see maps below).
